IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: Dogs of any breed who are at least 6 months of age that are registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the Canine Partners program may enter and must be spayed/neutered. Bitches in season may enter but must wear pants. A bitch in season may only be tested as the last dog in the last event.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

TEST ENTRY FEES: Each pre-entry \$25; pre-entries close Saturday, June 29, 2024. Each late entry is \$30 and will be accepted from June 30 through 12:30 pm, or until entry limits have been reached. Please check Sportsmen's Facebook page at [sportsmensdtc](https://www.facebook.com/sportsmensdtc) for updates.

Two Advanced tests must have been passed before you may enter the Retriever tests. In-person entries for the June 30, 2024 Retriever test will be accepted at the Advanced Fetch test held on June 29, provided entrant has passed two Advanced tests.

Pre-entries can be mailed, or can be dropped off at Sportsmen's drop box located inside the building until Wednesday, June 26, 2024 at 8 pm. Please send an email to the trial secretary if you drop off your entry.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Direct inquiries to Karen Angell at hoofnwooffarm@gmail.com. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35 fee for any returned checks.

Test 1 and test 2 will run consecutively. Running order will be determined by order of arrival.

Day-of entries will be run at the end of morning and afternoon sessions, after all pre-entries have been run. A dog may enter only once per test, and one test is defined as one event number.

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this test. Exhibitors should review all testing information found at www.akc.org/fetch/

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather or biothane.

REFUNDS There will be no refunds unless approved by the event committee. Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will not be available indoors. Dogs must be crated in cars. Please ensure your dog is comfortable and has water available. In warm weather, battery operated fans and Aluminet shade cloths are recommended. We are scheduling each team to take both tests during a 2-hour time slot to minimize waiting time. You may arrive any time during your assigned 2-hour time slot.

Testing site is private property. Please be respectful. Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.

Metamora, Michigan is horse country! Please drive slowly, as horses may be on the roads.

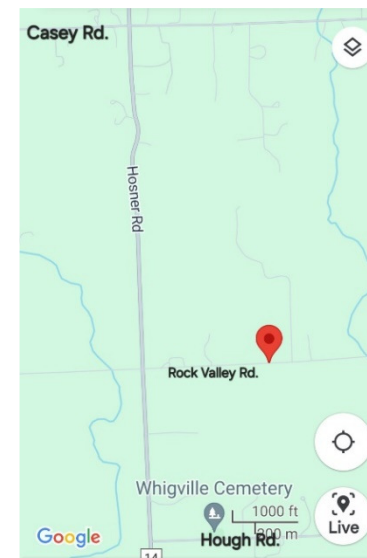
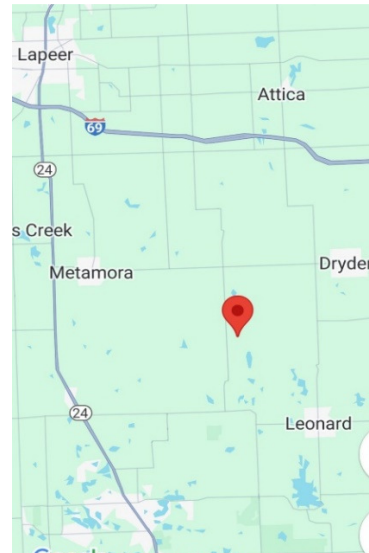

FROM THE SOUTH: I-75 to exit 81 M24 (Lapeer Rd) north toward Lapeer. Turn right(east) on Dryden Rd. Approximately 5.5 miles, turn tight on Hosner Rd. Pass Casey Rd and turn Left at the next road, Rock Valley Rd. Driveway is the second drive on the right, sign is Hoof'n'Woof Farm. Drive straight in, and park on the grass on the left side.

FROM THE NORTH: from I-69 east and west, exit at 155, go south to Dryden Rd., turn left. Then, same as above!

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
